Position Summary

A Campaign Leader/Assistant Campaign Leader (referred to as CL/ACL going forward) is responsible for ensuring that students on campus are **informed** of the education crisis in India, **inspired** in the role that the Teach For India Fellowship plays, and **invested** to apply to and join the program. The ideal candidate is committed, well-networked, high on taking initiative on campus, and has a reliable work ethic.

They will drive the Teach For India brand on their campus, embody Teach For India's core values and deliver results that will ensure Teach For India continues to fuel the movement that will end educational inequity.

Eligibility

- Must be enrolled in one of the Universities listed in our application form
- Should be a pre final year student for the ACL role or final year student for the CL role in any stream
- Must be able to attend our onboarding program virtually
- Must be able to devote 4 hours on average per week from August 2022 to April 2023 (The hours are flexible so you can manage your work schedule around your academic commitments)

Responsibilities

Primary responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Lay foundation for the establishment of the Campus Chapter (If required)
- Plan and organize high visibility events on campus for pre-final and final year students
- Connect Teach For India to key influencers Faculty/Deans/HOD
- Engage with campus student media
- Lead department engagement activities
- Support the Recruitment Manager with High Potential Talent identification in campus
- Drive attendance at TFI events
- Assist the college applicants to become a part of the Movement
- Be a credible voice and advocate of Teach For India
